### **Legal information**

### **Electronic publications**

### **Bill Tracker & Policy documents**

Bill Tracker supplies the text and full details of every Bill tabled before Parliament, including history, present status and parties likely to be affected by a Bill.

Complementary to the legislative information offered by Sabinet, are three Juta Law full-text products, covering;

- i.* **Statutes of South Africa (Juta Law)** is available full-text from 1910 to date. The product is presented in fully consolidated and annotated form and is updated monthly.
- ii.* **Provincial legislation (Juta law)** contains the consolidated ordinances to form a comprehensive and authoritative provincial legislative service, with monthly updates, new provincial laws, regulations and assigned Acts of Parliament, from 1994 to date.



*iii. Daily law reports* offers all judgements passed in South African courts of law and includes concise summaries of legal issues in each judgement. This product is available from 1997 onwards and is up-dated bi-weekly.
